
Target Rate Probabilities for 10 Dec 2025 Fed Meeting

FOMC PARTICIPANTS' ASSESSMENTS OF APPROPRIATE MONETARY POLICY : "DOT-PLOT"




Blue dots indicate the median projection. Data is based on the economic projections published on September 17, 2025. Red dots indicate the effective rate implied by the year-end FedFund future price.

The EU's plan to use frozen Russian assets to aid Ukraine has raised concerns in Belgium that it could subject them to severe legal and economic retaliation from Russia. EU officials insist the plan is crucial for Ukraine to maintain its economy while resisting Russian aggression and hope EU leaders will reach an agreement at this month's summit.

Malaysian Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim said that US chip giant Intel will invest an additional RM860 million in Malaysia, making it its packaging and testing center. This will further strengthen Malaysia's position in the global semiconductor supply chain. Malaysia is the world's sixth-largest exporter of microchips, holding a 13% share of the global chip packaging and testing market.

The Indian government previously instructed smartphone manufacturers to pre-install the state-owned cybersecurity app Sanchar Saathi on all new devices. Apple has explicitly stated it will not comply. This app, primarily used to track stolen phones, is currently available for download on the App Store and Google Play.

AWS announced that Anthropic's latest Claude 4.5 series models have officially launched on Amazon Bedrock, including the flagship Claude Opus 4.5, the mid-range Claude Sonnet 4.5, and the high-performance Claude Haiku 4.5.
