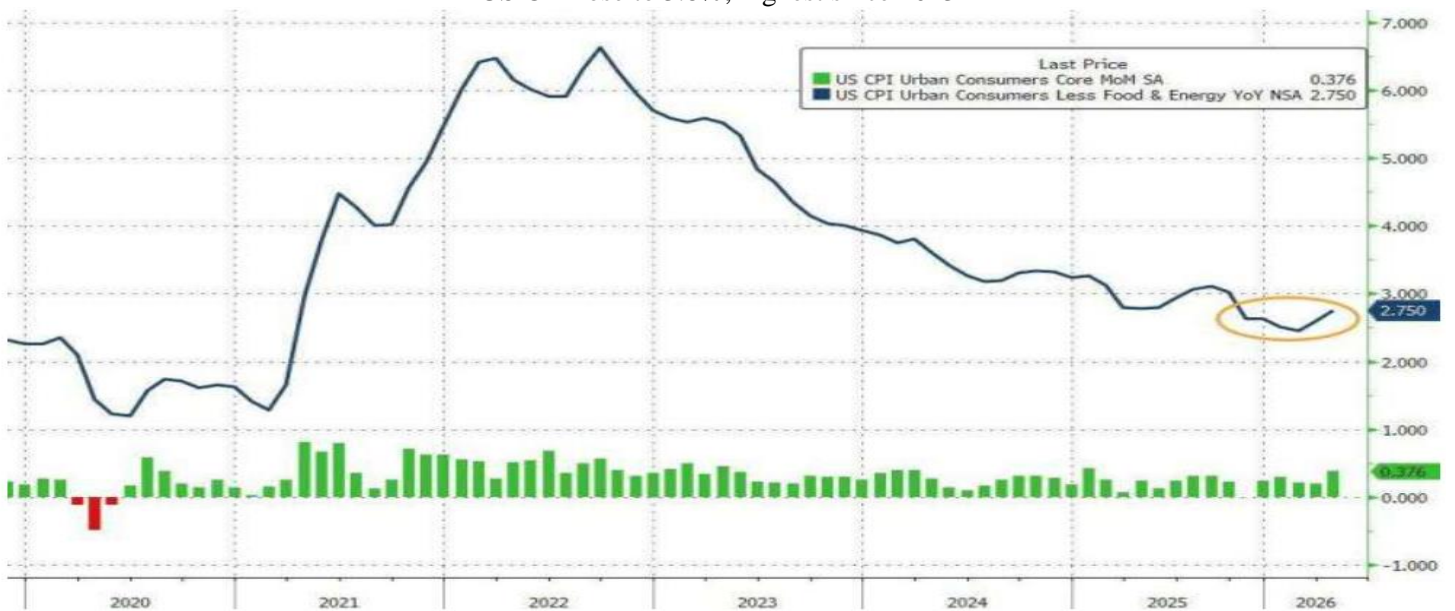

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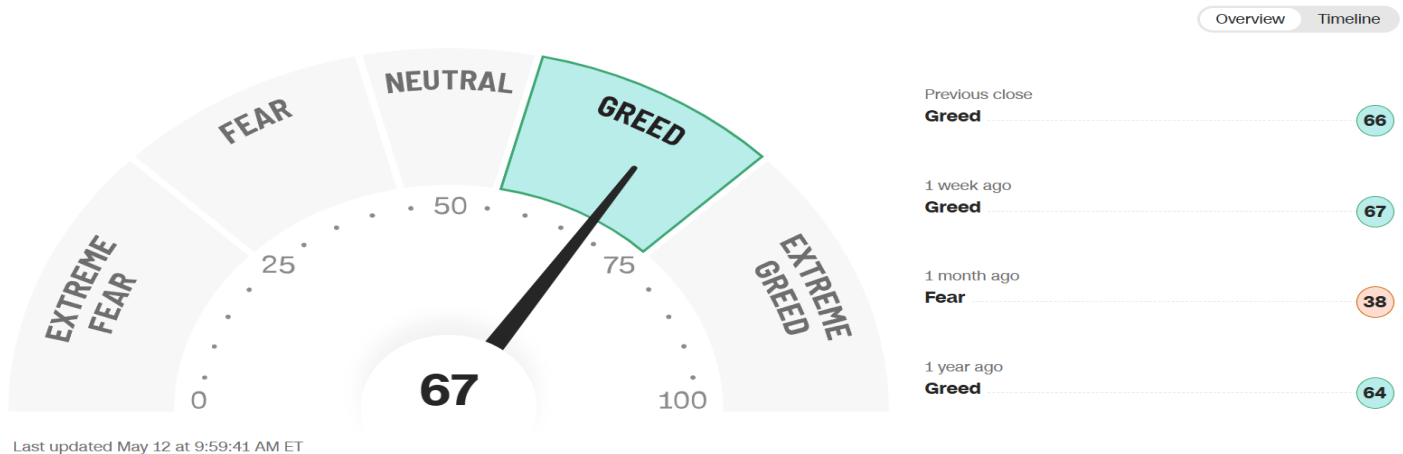

On May 8, following President Trump's instructions, the U.S. Department of Defense released the first batch of 162 declassified UFO-related documents on a dedicated government website. The documents, spanning decades and including videos, photographs, and eyewitness accounts, have been described by Chinese experts as a political maneuver to pave the way for a trillion-dollar space military program.

The Institute of Primary Facts, a U.S. organization advocating for transparency, held a pop-up exhibition in New York, displaying only one document: a printout of approximately 3.5 million pages of files related to the late sex offender billionaire P.E. Epstein, released by the U.S. Department of Justice in accordance with the law.

As the U.S.-Israel joint attack on Iran enters its 73rd day, the U.S. and UK have imposed new sanctions on Iran, and President Trump has warned that the ceasefire agreement is "at risk."

U.S. inflation rose faster than expected in April, with the Consumer Price Index (CPI) climbing to 3.8% year-over-year, the highest level since May 2023, driven by rising energy costs and food prices due to the conflict in Iran, coupled with adjustments to rent statistics that pushed up core service prices. This further reinforced market expectations that the Federal Reserve (Fed) will remain on hold in the short term, or even face renewed pressure to raise interest rates.

On Tuesday, U.S. e-commerce giant eBay (EBAY-US) officially rejected a \$56 billion acquisition offer from GameStop (GME-US) CEO Ryan Cohen. eBay Chairman Paul Pressler stated in a letter that the unsolicited bid was "neither reliable nor attractive."

G2 Meeting in Beijing

In the financial market, normally the G7 meeting is the most important meeting that would affect the global market. In the last decades, they wish to enlarge it to G13 or G14 so as to include China and other emerging economies. Later, because of the Financial Tsunami of 2008, the G20 minister meeting was upgraded to a leaders' summit, going together parallelly with G7 meetings. But, apparently the G2 meeting of US and China now attracts the world's attention most for it is not held annually like G7 or G20.

How would it affect the investment market worldwide? Very simple, there are 17 CEOs going with Trump to China, watch the list as per attached. Mind that the largest capitalization company NVDA is not on the list. The White House said this time is not for AI but for buying soybeans. Those that had a market diary should know that at the beginning of this year, the business outlook for NVDA already skipped off China. That is still would grow fast and still would be in the leading position. However, when with China, should be a little better at least psychologically.

The sales of Boeing may be the largest among the 17 companies, at least 500 sets of 737 will be ordered by China, once even said to be another 100 sets of 787. Actually, everything was confirmed before the trip, this trip is for signing of contracts rather than negotiation.

META still will go to China, even now inside China it cannot be downloaded or used, but in the US or worldwide market, there are a lot of advertisements


from Alibaba and other Chinese companies. It is quite ironic that since China entered into WTO in 2001, they promised to open their internet market to let western countries run inside China. But now all Chinese companies can enter into the US but US companies like Facebook, Google, YouTube, WhatsApp, Amazon cannot enter China for they need to protect their local industries, and even said now VPN will be banned soon. However, all American presidents cannot see even if they have eyes, cannot hear even if they have ears, cannot speak even if they have mouth, including Bill Clinton, George Bush, Barack Obama, Donald Trump 1.0, Joe Biden and Donald Trump 2.0. The WTO and UN are all the same; blind, deaf and dumb after all.

G7 and G20 are actually not so important for it is just a forum, will not sign any contract, only have a joint declaration. Last year Trump even skipped the APEC in Korea and only gave a recorded speech and stayed 3 days in Japan and one day in Korea before the meeting.

Donald Trump is traveling to China this week with a delegation of 17 top U.S. CEOs from major companies including Apple, Tesla/SpaceX, BlackRock, Boeing, Citi, Goldman Sachs, Meta, Micron, Qualcomm, and Visa. These executives are part of the official delegation, but reports indicate that not all of them will physically board Air Force One with Trump—some may travel separately due to schedules.
